Community Outreach Ministries (COM) has partnered with Computer Recycling Center (CRC) to provide a means for Polk County to easily and securely dispose of old electronics. E-scrap may be dropped off inside COM's thrift store any time the store is open.

In addition to recycling old electronics, **data-containing devices** (computers, cell phones, tablets, CDs, flash drives) are sent to CRC to be destroyed, ensuring that your personal information remains private.
